



WHAT YOU NEED:

- Colored Ribbons
- · Old beads or buttons
- · Needle and thread

SMALL CHRISTMAS TREES

Christmas is approaching and to decorate our home we need some new and environmentally friendly idea.

The fir trees are evergreen trees that populate our forests. It is important to protect them and not cut them only to decorate our homes.

If you can't plant a decorated fir tree in your garden do not worry, you can make a small Christmas tree with recycled materials such as old buttons, plastic or fabric tape, colored beads, etc.

This is what you have to do:

- 1. With a thread make a ring and attach it to the first bead. In this way you will be able to hang your special tree wherever you want.
- 2. Then with a needle, starting from the top, slip the first bead in the thread alternating it with the ribbon. While doing this give to the ribbon the shape of the tree.
